## LITTLE EXPLORERS

In **Little Explorers**, JUMP teams up with the **Pacific Science Center** to offer campers a unique opportunity to dive into scientific exploration, getting messy while learning about the world around them in new, exciting ways. While at the Pacific Science Center, campers will have VIP access to demonstrations, science shows and exhibits prior to opening. **Full-day program is for 4- to 7-year-olds. Campers spend time at the EEU and PSC, with drop off and pick up at both locations on alternating days.**

## BOTANICAL ADVENTURES

Time to jump into the great outdoors! # FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### WHAT IS THE CAMPER-TO-COUNSELOR RATIO?

We have a minimum staff to camper ratio of 1:4 onsite and 1:3 for field trips. Each camp accommodates 16 campers, and is staffed by 4-5 counselors. Camps are led by a master's level early childhood special educator or an advanced grad student, supported by an additional 3-4 counselors, including graduate and undergrad students interested in special education, speech-language pathology, or occupational therapy.

### DOES JUMP ACCEPT INSURANCE?

JUMP does not take insurance at this time.

### WHERE IS THE CAMP LOCATED?

JUMP takes place at the Experimental Education Unit, with frequent field trips. Little Explorers spends time at the Pacific Science Center, requiring drop off/pick up there on certain days.

### HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO ATTEND CAMP? ARE THERE SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE?

### WHAT DOES A TYPICAL DAY AT CAMP LOOK LIKE?

The day kicks off with small group work, where campers practice social skills through novel activities. In the afternoon, campers get into the community, through "community connections." While these community connections may vary from camp to camp, we take time to prepare through play-based learning.

### WHO GOES TO JUMP SUMMER CAMP?

Children with special needs, peers, and siblings are all encouraged to attend. Our program is designed for kids between ages of 3-7.

### DOES MY CHILD NEED TO BE TOILET TRAINED?

We'll support kids where ever they are at with toileting needs and potty training!
